**Design Engineer**: is responsible for designing an aerodynamic body shell for the car. The Design Engineer will need to discuss ideas with the Manufacturing Engineer to make sure that their ideas are possible.

**Graphic Designer**: is responsible for the **aesthetics** of the car and will oversee the design of the team's logo and uniform. The Graphic Designer is also in charge of the presentation of the portfolio of work.


